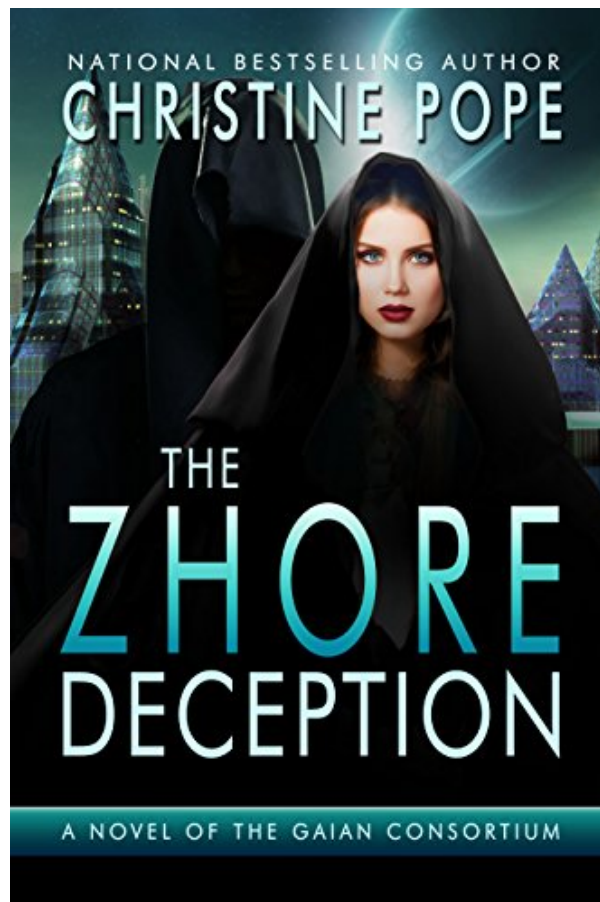
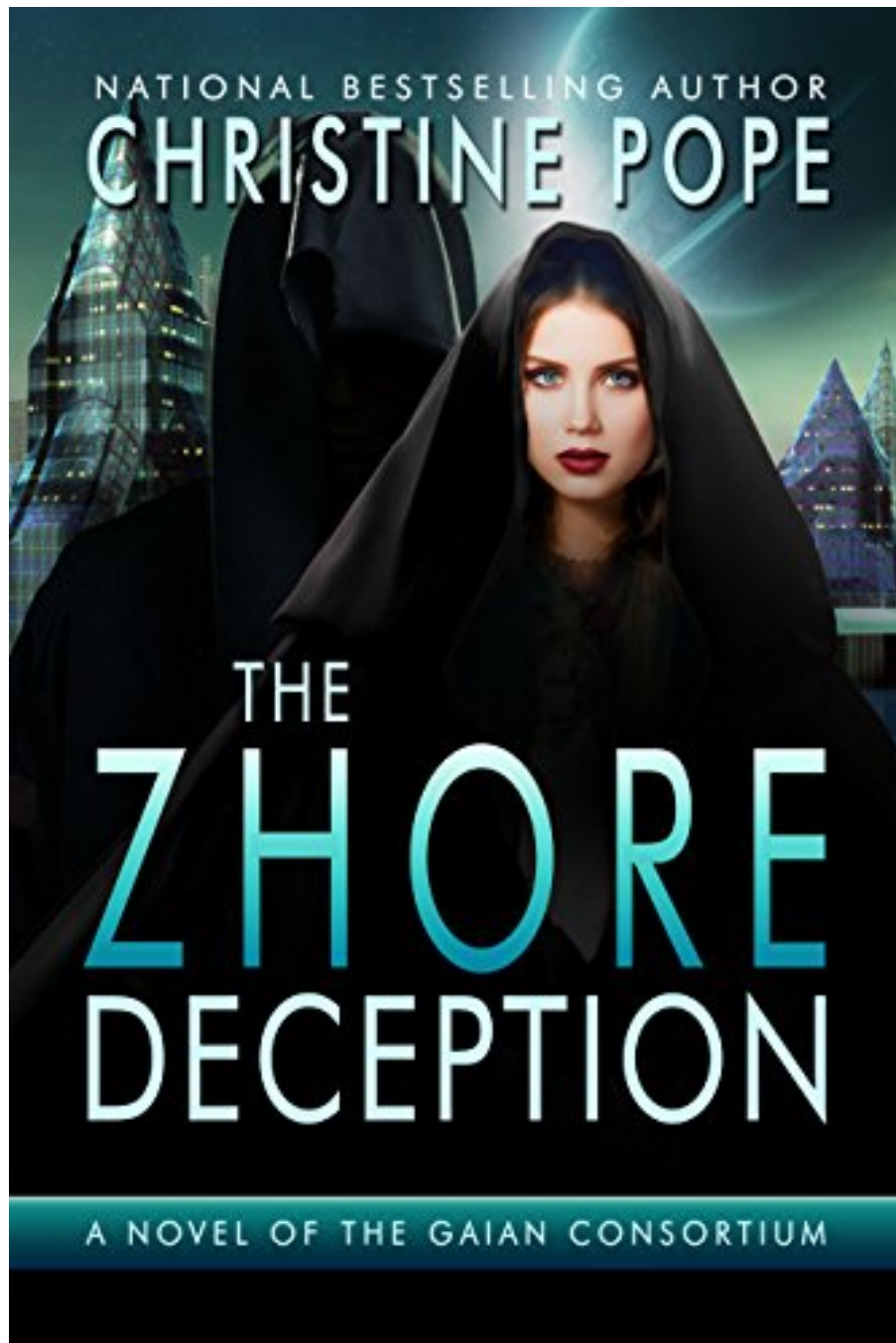

The Zhores were zzzz....., but I still recommend this series finale

This is advertised as the last of Christine Pope's Gaian Consortium books. These books have been a 5-star thrill ride since introduced in 2011. They are full of action-adventure, heroic main characters, inspired secondary characters, slow-building but ultimately hot romantic relationships, and slices of humor. Sadly, nearly all of those things on the list were disappointing in this final installment. Superb story-telling and world-building are up to Pope's usual perfect standard, and hence the three stars.

Trinity Knox, a talented psychic with unknown and untapped potential, gets caught by the Consortium government after using her gift for less-than-noble purposes. So immediately I am not thrilled with the heroine, who is dumb about a man and cheats to get ahead. Unfortunately, her questionable interactions with the Consortium scum who blackmail her into spying on the Zhore don't further endear her to the reader. Pope has written some morally ambiguous characters in the past who finally see the light, so I was holding out hope. Unfortunately any epiphany for Trinity was about personal needs rather than the greater good.

Trinity and Zhandar don't meet until about a third of the way into the book. It takes that long to set the stage, which made the story drag a little for me. I was excited to finally explore the mysterious Zhoraan home world, which Pope has been teasing us with since Book 1, Breath of Life. It did not disappoint. Much was made of the Zhore's beautiful, integrated naturalism, which seems so oddly counterpoint to the robed, standoffish natives.

Trinity arrives on Zhoraan uncomfortable with her deception. Her psychic skills are necessary shields against the highly empathic Zhores. But Big Brother Consortium isn't leaving anything to chance and He is also watching.....

Zhandar is a normal Zhore with a normal job. He's kind of unexciting. Dare I say....beta. He just didn't have the appeal for me that Pope's other Zhore heroes, Sarzhin (Breath of Life) and Lazhir (The Mandala Maneuver) exuded. The Zhore are pacifists, but they also seem humorless. I missed Pope's irreverence that popped up in her other books. Because Trinity was masquerading as a Zhore, even she couldn't cut loose with humor or emotion or anger. Everything was so staid that the normal highs and lows you experience in a developing romantic relationship were absent. There weren't even nifty side characters to provide a little relief from the serious tone.

Despite my middling rating for this series finale, I still recommend this book for anyone who has followed the Gaians, Stacians and Zhores through their epic journey. And I very highly recommend ALL of the preceding books. Kudos to Ms. Pope for the excellent epilogue. Readers will most fully understand it if they have read the other Gaian Consortium books. Then you will cheer like I did.

Passing for Zhore

This is a very good conclusion(?) to a highly entertaining series. In fact, it's my favorite book in the series, nudging out book three for that honor. And while the Gaian computer hacker Jackson from book three has a cameo appearance, the Zhore are the real stars of this book.

Trinity Knox, a Gaian mind reader, has been duped by her co-worker and lover into embezzling funds from their employer. On his way off planet, her lover tips the authorities to her actions and she wakes up in a holding facility. There she learns the acquisitive and morally challenged Gaians plan to use her to infiltrate and spy on the Zhores on their own planet, a planet that doesn't allow admittance to non Zhores. She will be biologically altered to "pass" as a Zhore. Her mission on Zhoraan will be to become pregnant, then return to her handler so the hybrid baby can be studied by Gaian scientists. Her only option is a guaranteed stint in MaxSec, a prison housing very few female prisoners, ensuring her total sexual subjugation.

Meanwhile, on Zhoraan, landscape architect, Zhander, is still grieving the death of his bonded mate and their unborn child a year earlier. He is attending mandatory counseling, the progress of which is reported to the health ministry, when a health ministry official takes over one of his sessions. Zhander is told it is time for him to move on, to help save Zhoraan by fathering another child. The government has even come up with a way around sayara, the mating attraction necessary for conception by engineering a drug that forces the attraction. Zhander is at first appalled at what they are asking of him, but ultimately agrees to participate in their endeavor. Then his assistant goes on retreat just in time for "Zhanna", a Zhore from the other side of the planet, to step in and take over the job. Both immediately feel the sayara, but hold their feelings back. Zhander because custom dictates he must determine if she feels the same before approaching her. And Zhanna/Trinity because she has been implanted with a device that allows her handler to see and hear everything, including her biometrics. Everything that should be private between her and the Zhore she respects and is beginning to love.
